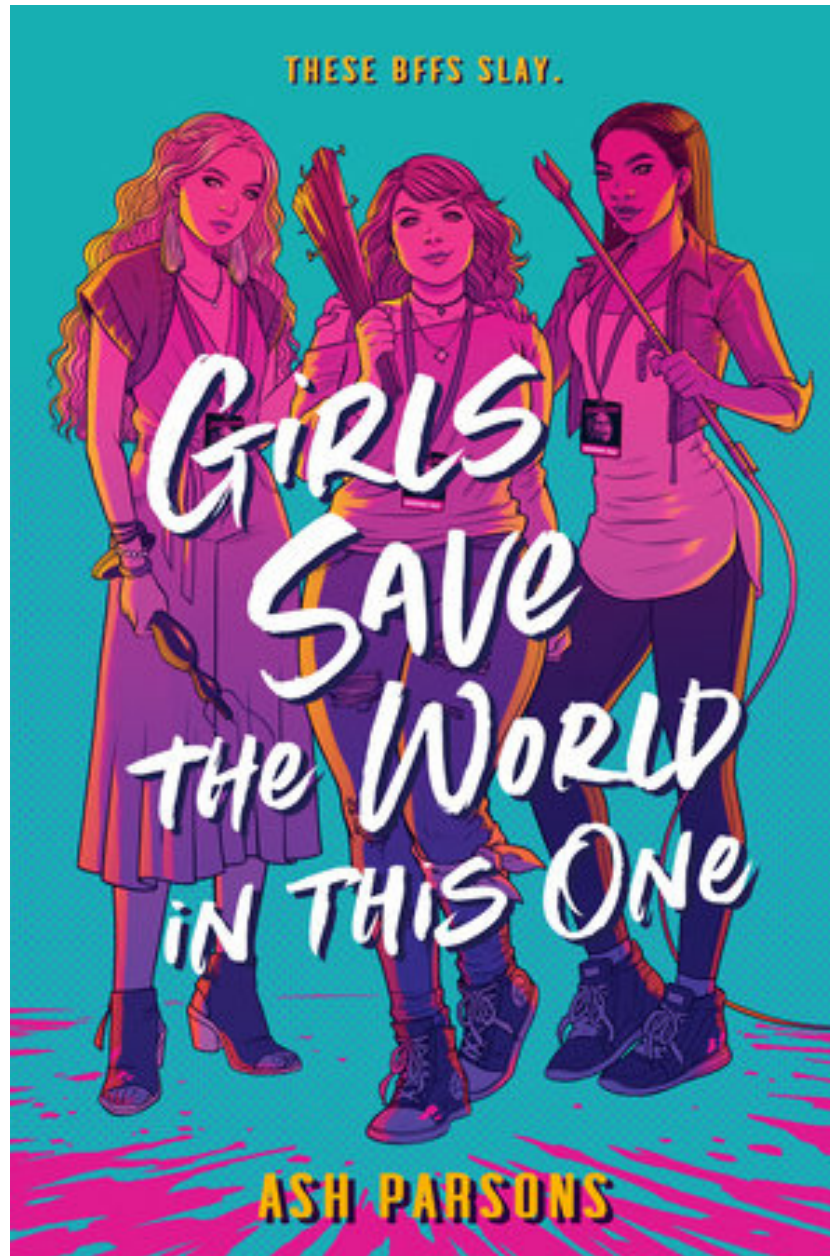

The premise is interesting, June and her friends have been anticipating going to an event for their favourite TV show, Human Wasteland, and meeting all the actors. The immediate thought when I added these and got zombies was how interesting it would be for June to meet the real people, and find out what they're like in real life. However this character/person contrast was never explored.

However I quickly worked out a major flaw in the story - Human Wasteland is an entirely fictional TV show. Which did mean that we were treated to 13 chapters of constant infodumping on June's break up, the TV show, the characters backstories. The problem was, I don't like The Walking Dead, which this was clearly based around (any Z Nation fans out there?) and it's actually really hard to pretend to have any interest in a fake zombie TV show with stereotypical survival characters.

Another thing I have to add because it was really strange, June had the biggest Gay Energy I have ever seen, yet was written as completely straight. When she looked at her friends she describes the way they smile, the way they smell, the way they do things that makes her love them, but when she sees a boy she's supposed to be attracted to it just becomes, 'oh, cute boy.'
